Copyright – statement of policy

It is FEIIC's practice, together with many other publishers of academic journals, to ask you to assign to the publisher the copyright of papers accepted for publication. The reasons for this are as follows:

- Ownership of copyright by the publisher tends to ensure maximum international protection against infringement, libel or plagiarism.
- It enables the publisher to deal efficiently with requests from third parties to reproduce or reprint a paper, or part of it, and in accordance with a general policy which is sensitive both to any relevant changes in international copyright and to the general desirability of encouraging the dissemination of knowledge.
- You are responsible for making sure that you have the right to publish everything in your paper. If you use material from a copyrighted source (including your own previously published material) you must get permission from the copyright holder. If you are in doubt about whether or not permission is required, please contact the publisher. Failure to obtain such permission would be an infringement of copyright and could, in some circumstances, lead to litigation.
- Your assignment of copyright signifies your agreement to its publication and storage electronically, and its distribution via document delivery services.
- In assigning your copyright you are not forfeiting your proprietary rights, including patent rights. You retain the right to use your own paper in the following ways, provided you acknowledge the published original in standard bibliographic citation form, and no sales are involved. After publication, you are free to use your paper for the internal purposes of your own institution or company; mounted on your own or your institution's website; posted to free public e-print servers; or in whole or in part, as the basis for your own further publications or spoken presentations.

In summary, by signing the copyright form you certify that:

1. You have informed all of your co-authors of the terms of this agreement and are signing on their behalf.
2. Your contribution is your original work, has not been published before and is not being considered for publication elsewhere.
3. You have obtained permission for and acknowledged the source of excerpts from other copyright works.
4. To the best of your knowledge the paper contains no statements that are libelous, unlawful or in anyway actionable.
